Risks and uncertainties are among the key challenges facing modern societies. This is true for infrastructures as well as for social and political problems. Modern societies are characterised by different perspectives and ambiguities. As a result, new moral conflicts and conflicting values are emerging.

Whether in technology or society, subjective perceptions lead to compromise, which results in suboptimal solutions at best. These are risky and controversial and invite conflict. As a result, there is talk of a “return of uncertainty”. The consequence of this is a greater need for research. It will be of critical importance for the future to conduct research on and objectivise different risk and security perspectives in an interdisciplinary manner.
