Learning outcomes

Work placement: Having acquired well-founded basic knowledge in the field of political and social sciences, students are to apply their knowledge and skills in a practical work environment. Students will consolidate lessons learned and cultivate contacts in practical fields of application of political and social sciences at a relevant social-scientific institution: political parties and special interest organisations, NGOs, German federal or state

parliament(s), commissions, government bodies, international organisations, political foundations, etc. The work placement is meant to prepare the student for his or her professional career after the study programme.

Summer school: Summer schools have become a well-established option for further education open to international students. They are organised by universities and research institutes in Germany and abroad. Summer schools enable students to gain additional knowledge and experience abroad as well as acquire or improve language skills, thus gaining important soft skills.

Foreign language courses will not count towards the completion of the summer module except in specifically justified exceptional cases.

Content

Work placement: During their work placement, students should be either included in the everyday operations of the organisation taking them on, or work on one or more typical, project-related tasks that may be outside those everyday operations. The work placement should complement the theoretical and empirical analyses of the study programme by adding practical tasks. The specific content depends on the work placement in question and the tasks involved. The choice of a work placement must be made in consultation with a faculty member. The minimum duration is 4 weeks; the recommended duration is 8 weeks.

Summer school: The content taught at the chosen summer school depends on the focus of that summer school. The minimum duration is 4 weeks.
